- How does the idea fulfil the criteria of scientific and technological excellence? (maximum 3000 characters spaces included)
- How does the idea fulfil the criteria of sustainability and impact? (maximum 3000 characters spaces included)

Video submission

You are now invited to upload the video presenting your idea (max 10MB)
