As one of the [first signatories](#) of the [2017 European Open Science Cloud \(EOSC\) Declaration](#) and as one of the four [founding Members of the EOSC Association](#), our association has been and remains a strong supporter and constructive partner in developing and implementing the EOSC.


1. [Curriculum vitae](#) (max. two A4 pages)
